

How the PEV Rebate Program Works

Public Agency submits a complete application package BOTH online and a hardcopy postmarked by the application deadline. The Air District will review the application within 45 calendar days of receipt. If the application IS approved, the Air If the application IS NOT District will issue Public Agency a Voucher approved, the Air District will for each approved vehicle. provide Public Agency an explanation of its determination. **Voucher and funding award(s)** Vouchers may be redeemed for up to 120 **EXPIRE** if NOT redeemed within days after the issuance. 120 days after issuance. To redeem the Voucher within 120 days after issuance, Public Agency must: 1) purchase or lease the approved vehicle; AND 2) submit evidence of compliance with all Program Requirements, including Vehicle Purchase Form, Vehicle Purchase Agreement, proof of insurance, DMV Registration, and photos of vehicle and odometer. Failure to meet any PEV Voucher **Program Requirement** will result Public Agency having to repay the Air District a prorated amount of the award. Public Agency must operate each Voucherfunded vehicle within the Air District's jurisdiction for at least 3 years AND operate each Voucher-funded vehicle for a minimum of 15,000 miles.
